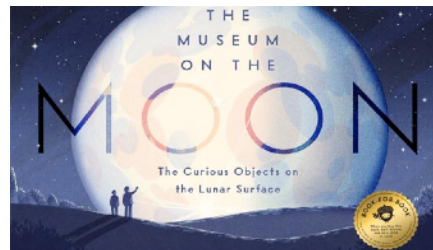
### NATIONAL LIBRARY CARD SIGN UP MONTH
